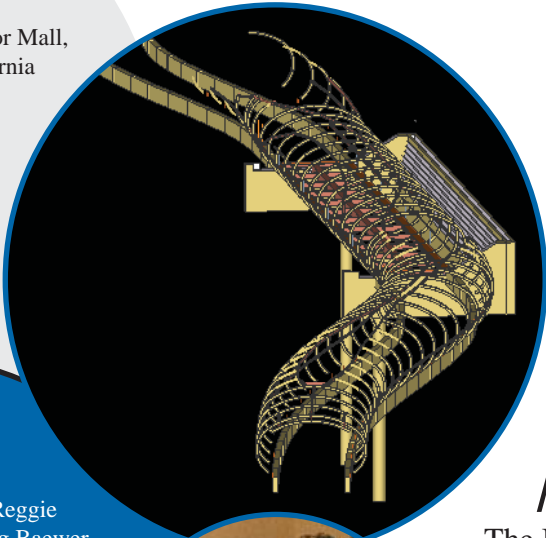

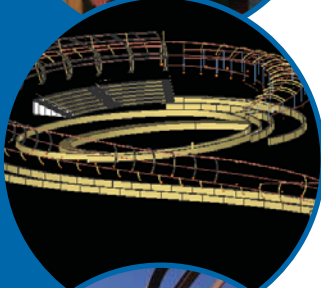

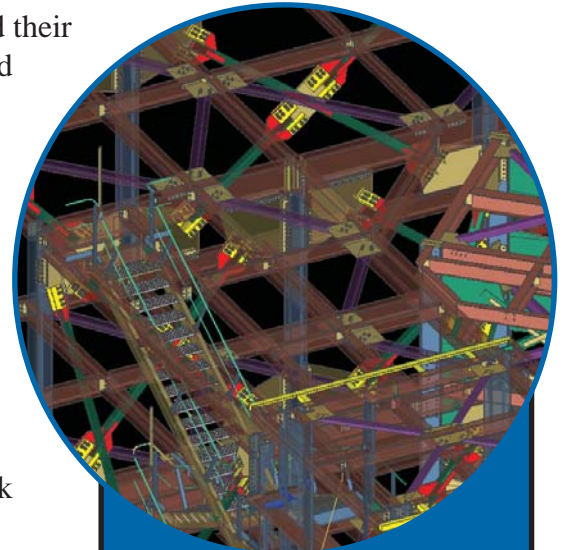
Outdoor Amphitheater

Dos Lagos Project.



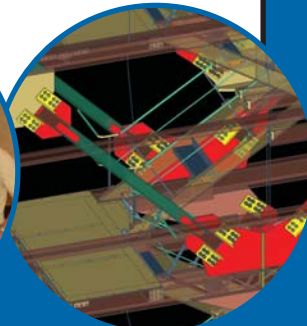
